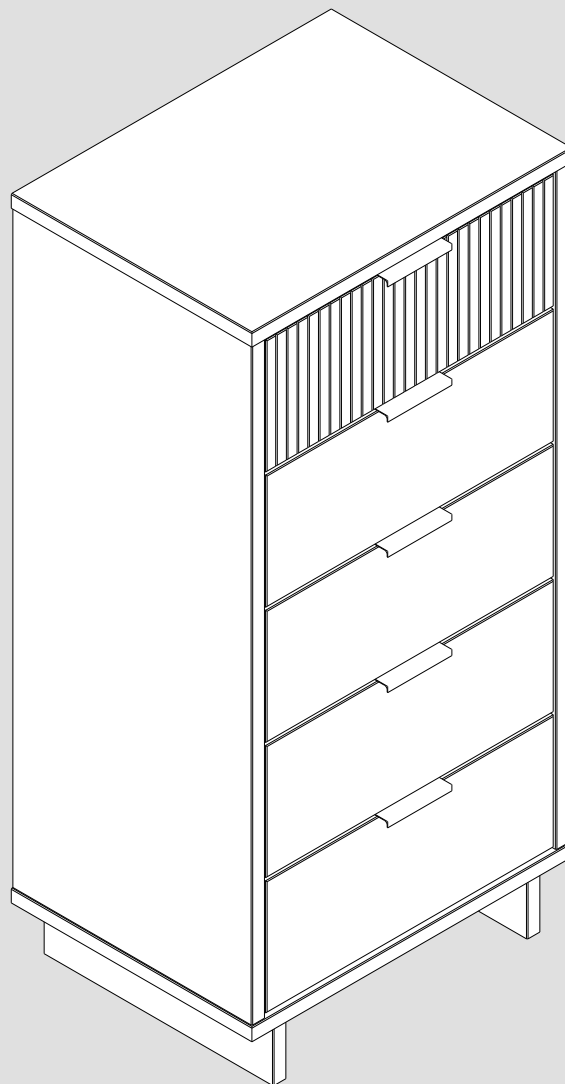


⚠ WARNING: To avoid serious personal injury:

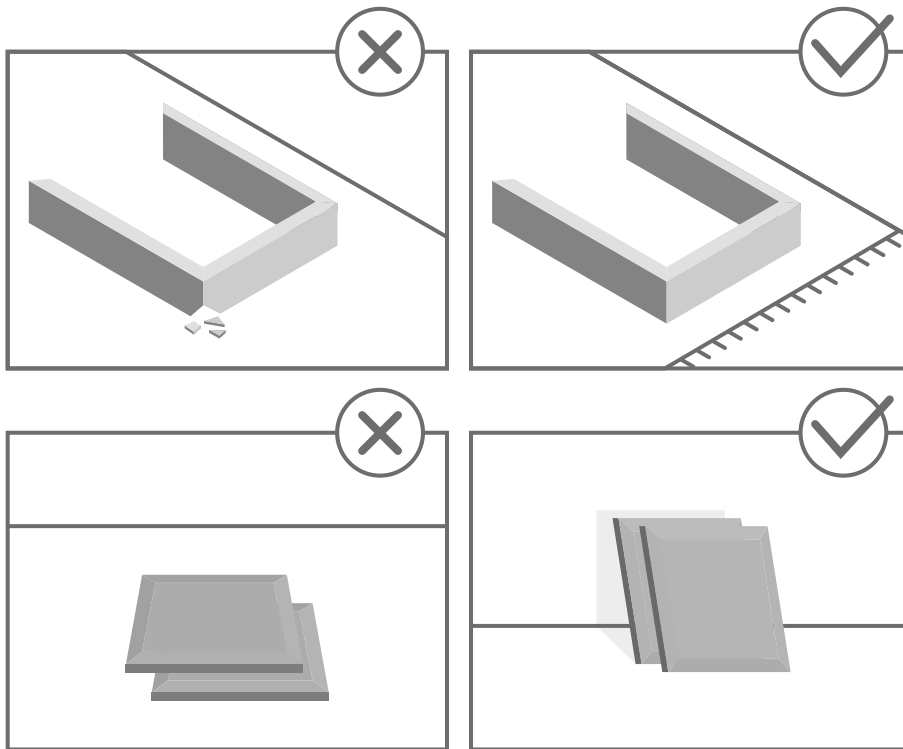

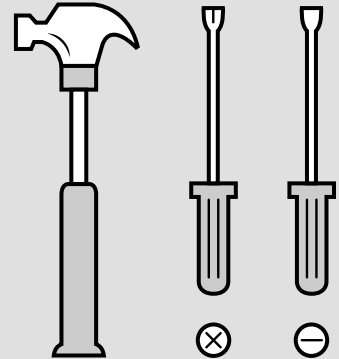
Before beginning the assembly process, ensure all boxes and parts have been delivered.

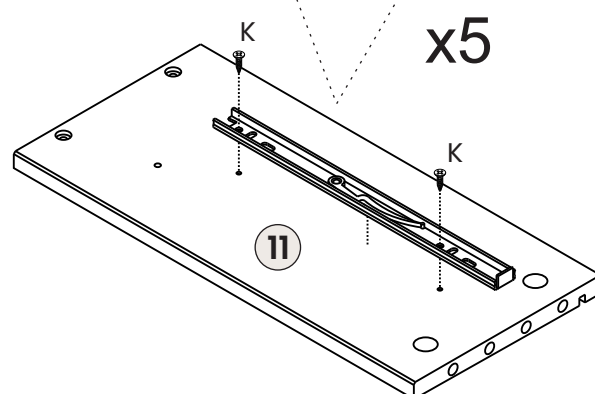
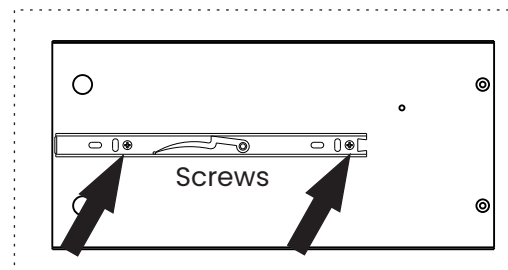
The sides of the drawers have pre-defined holes to help with fixing.

Insert the drawer carefully. You must put a drawer opening limiter screw.

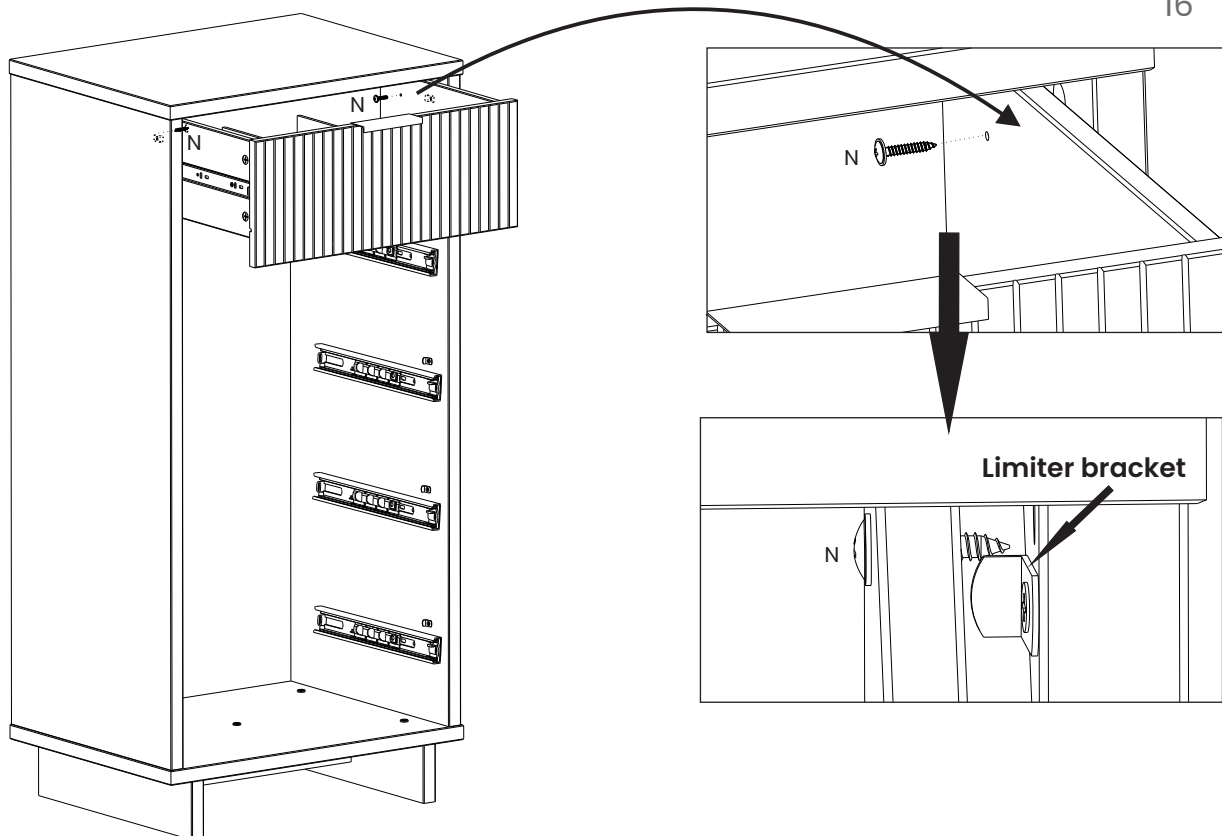
Firstly, keep the drawer partially open so that the limiter screw hole is behind the limiter bracket according to the detail.

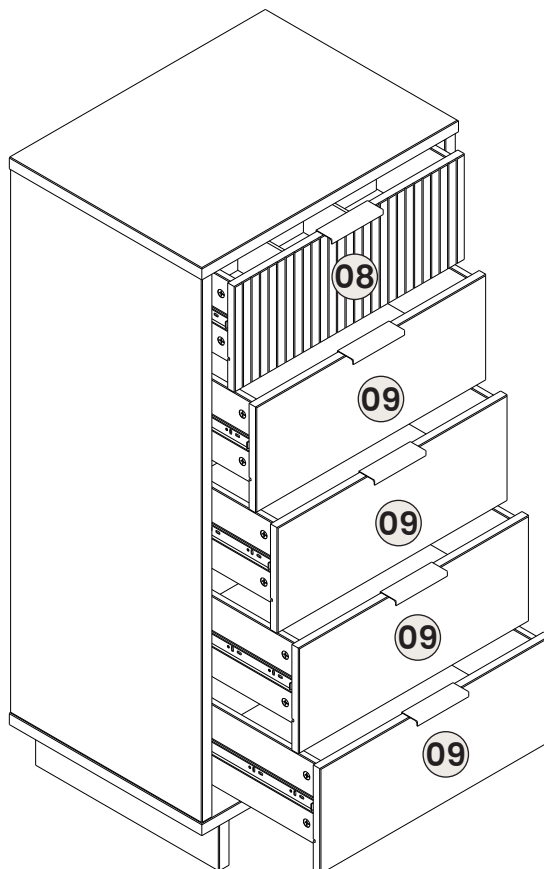

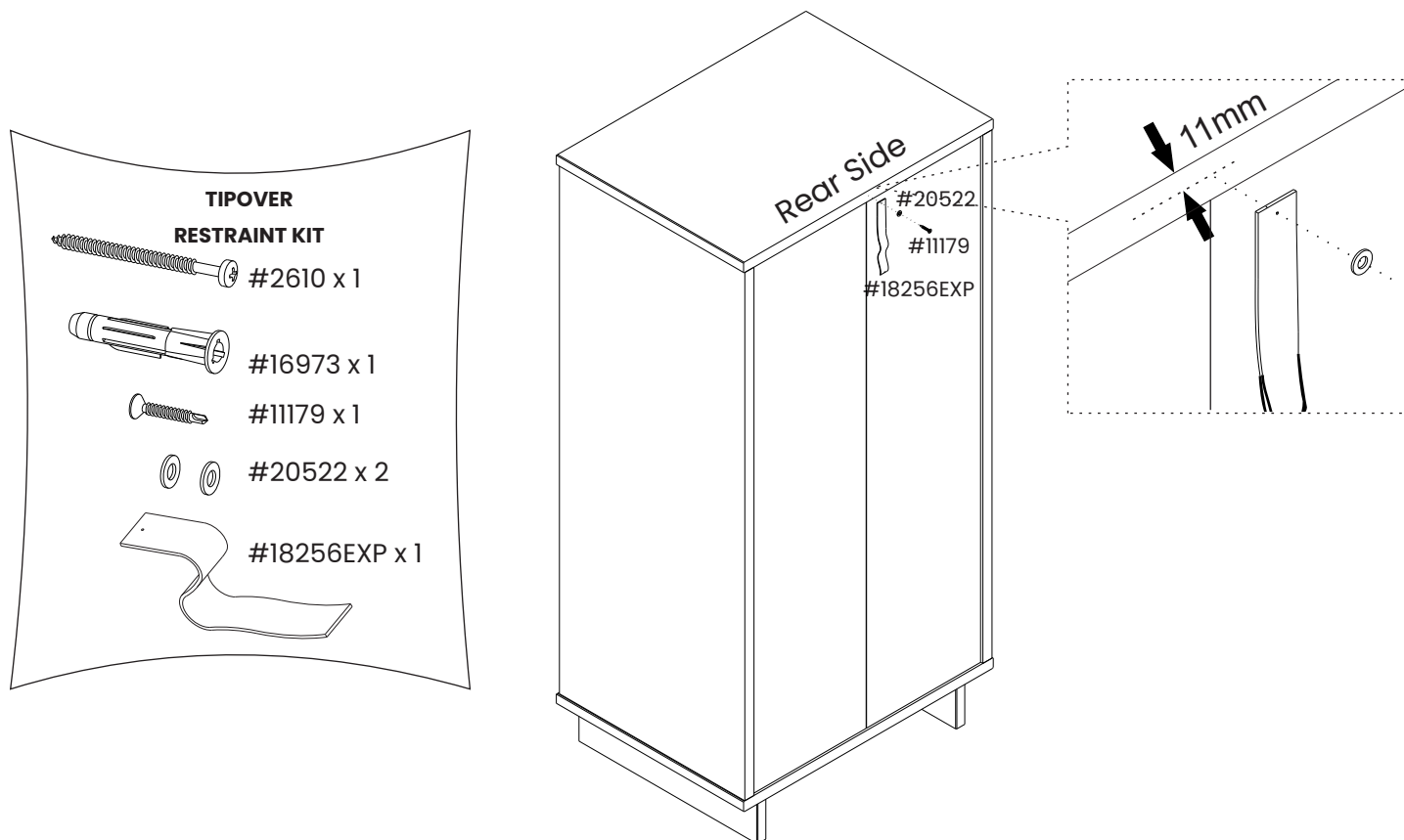

Fix them with screw #11179.

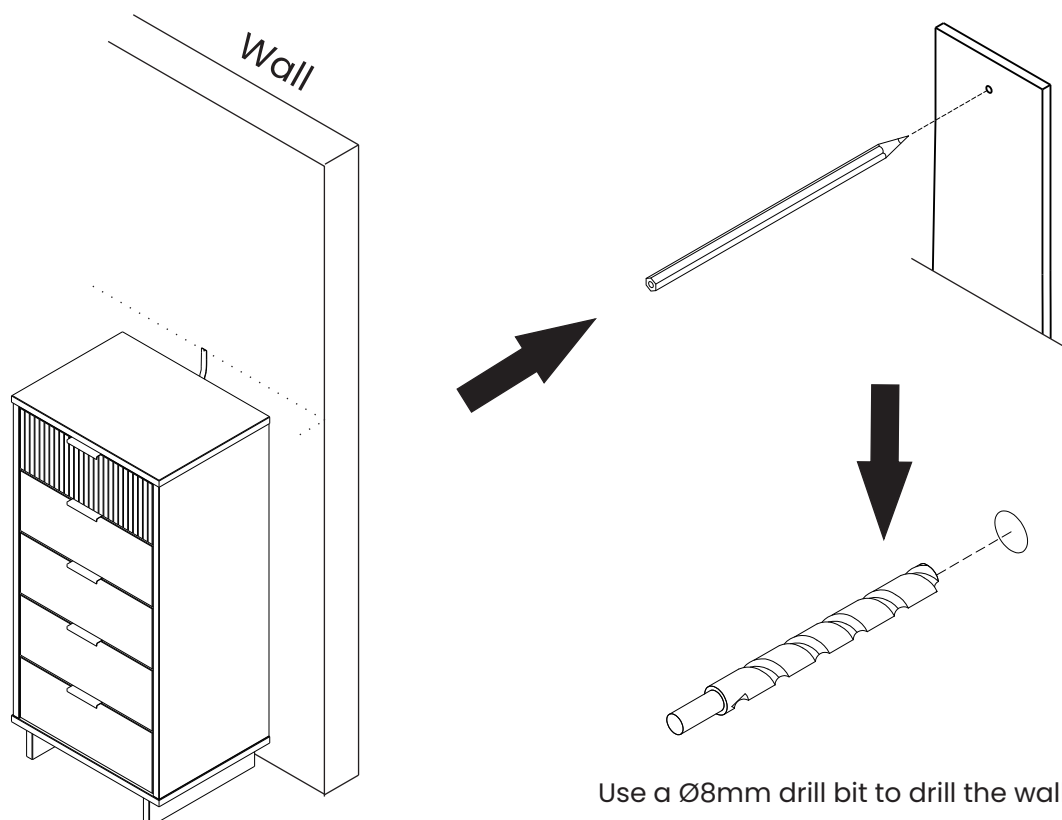

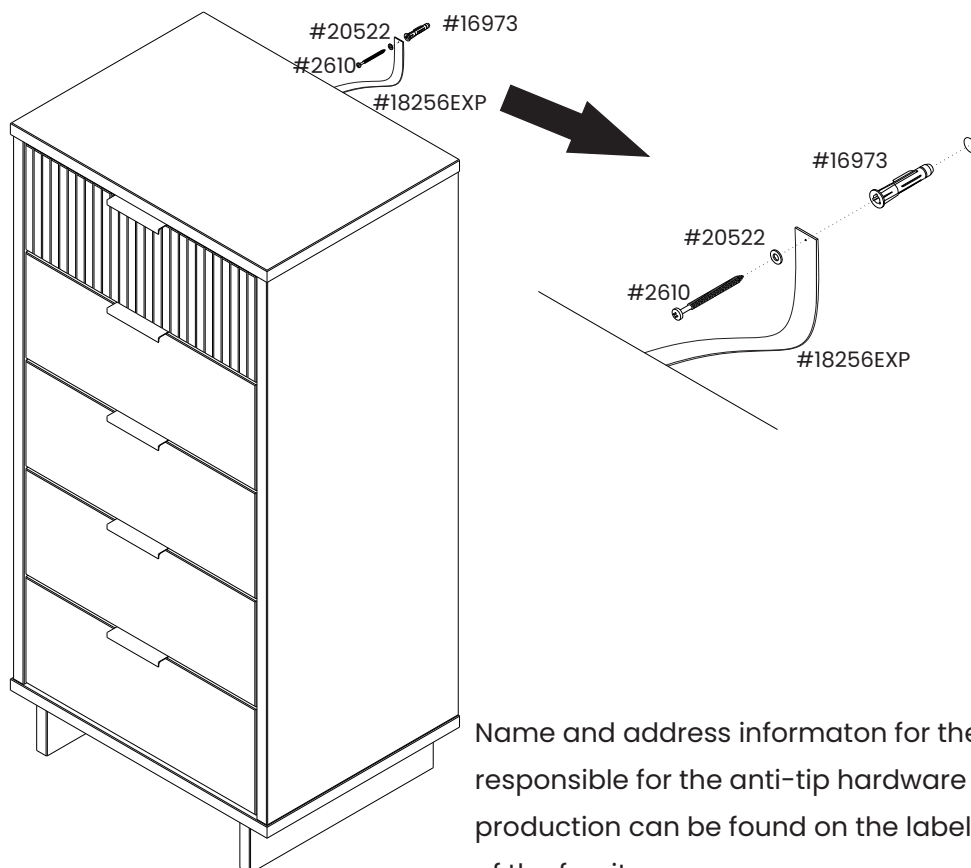
Approach the furniture as close as possible to the wall.

Then, mark with a pencil where you should drill the wall to put in the hardware.



Use a Ø8mm drill bit to drill the wall.

Put in the hardware #16973 to the hole that you drilled on the wall.
Then, position the hardware #18256EXP and #20522.
Finally, fix them with screw #2610.
