Note: When placing the furniture on non-carpeted flooring, it is recommended to use some type of floor protection such as an area rug or furniture pads under the chair glides. Area rugs and padding are not included with purchase.

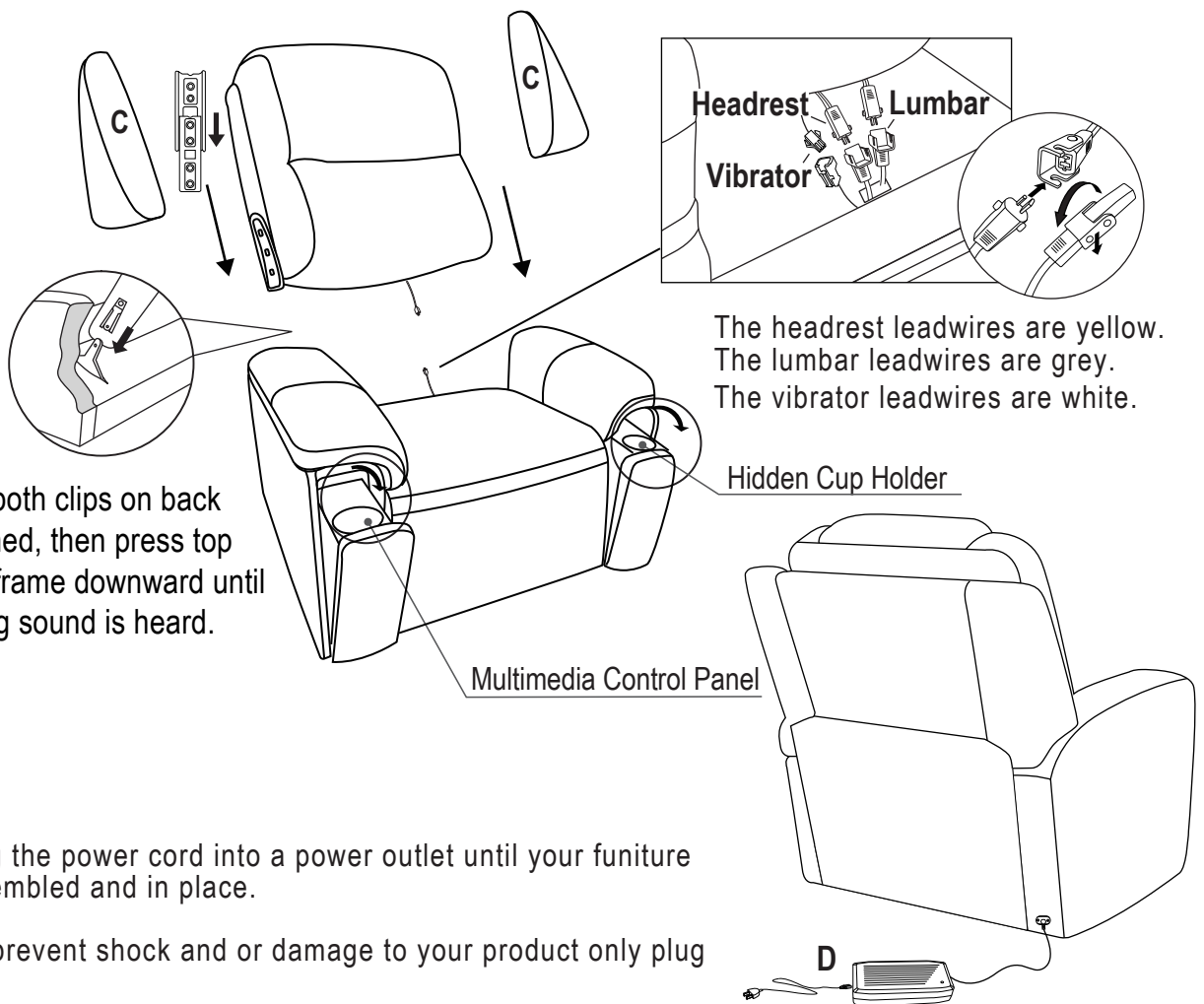
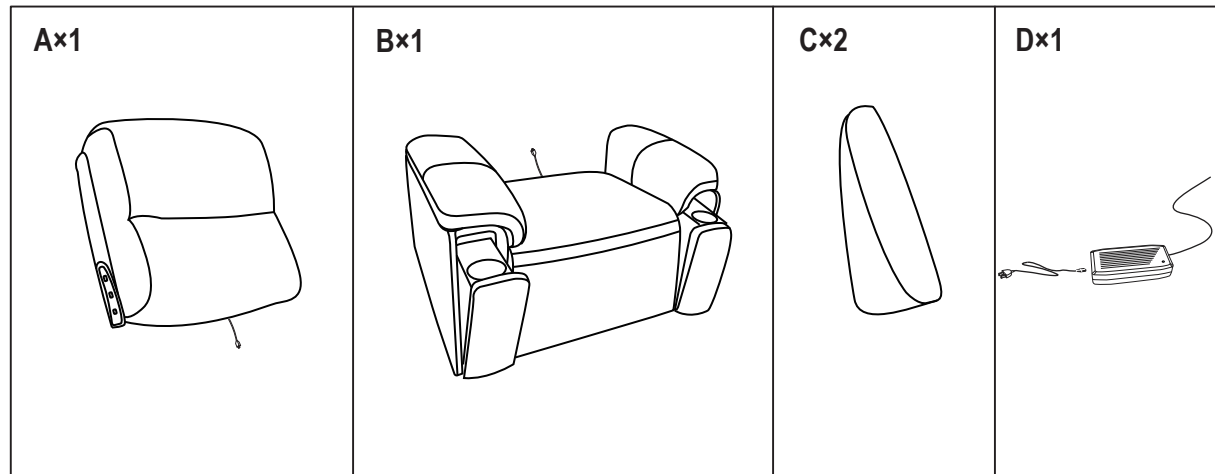
RECLINER ASSEMBLY

ATTACHING THE RECLINER BACK TO THE RECLINER BASE

Thank you for purchasing this quality product. Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment.

Inside the carton you will find two red plastic bags that have the recliner's wings in it. Remove the wings from the plastic bags and set them aside to be used in assembly and installation.

Make sure to read the instructions below before assembling your Home Theater Recliner.



Do Not plug the power cord into a power outlet until your furniture is fully assembled and in place.

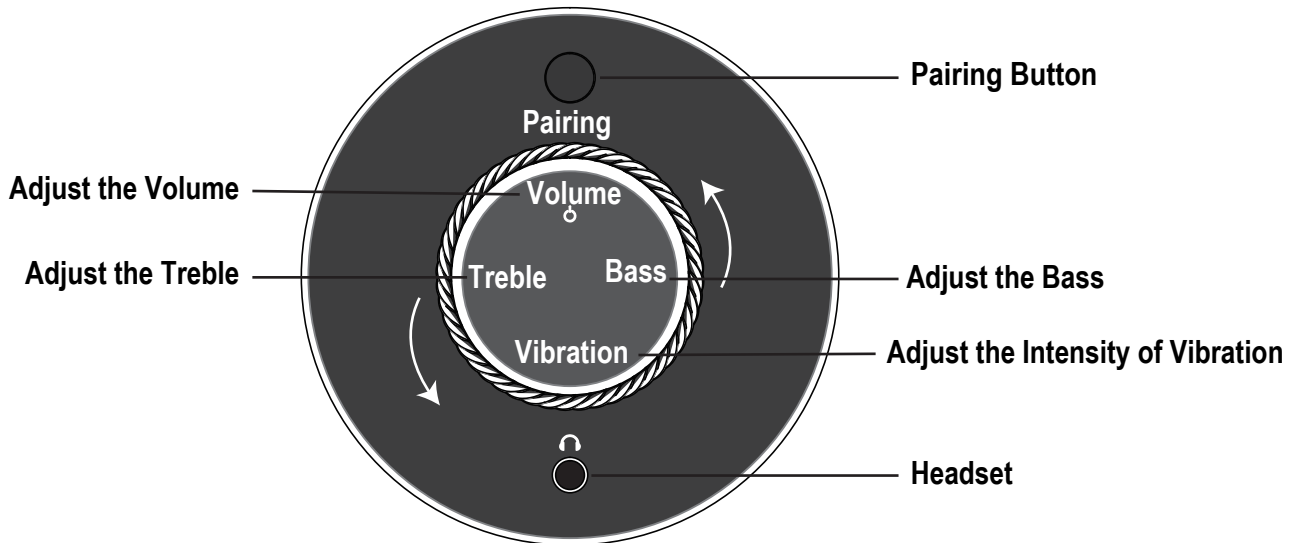

Multimedia Control Panel



How to Connect Wireless

Press and hold the  button, the LED on the button will light up. Press and hold the Pairing button, the LED on the button will flash to indicate that the control is in "pair" mode. Switch on the pairing function on your device.

How to Adjust the Treble

Press the Treble button to activate the treble function, rotate to adjust the treble level.

How to Adjust the Bass

Press the Bass button to activate the bass function, rotate to adjust the bass level.

How to Adjust the Vibration

Press the Vibration button to activate the vibration function, rotate to adjust the vibration level.

How to switch off all functions

Press and hold the  button to switch the multimedia control panel off.

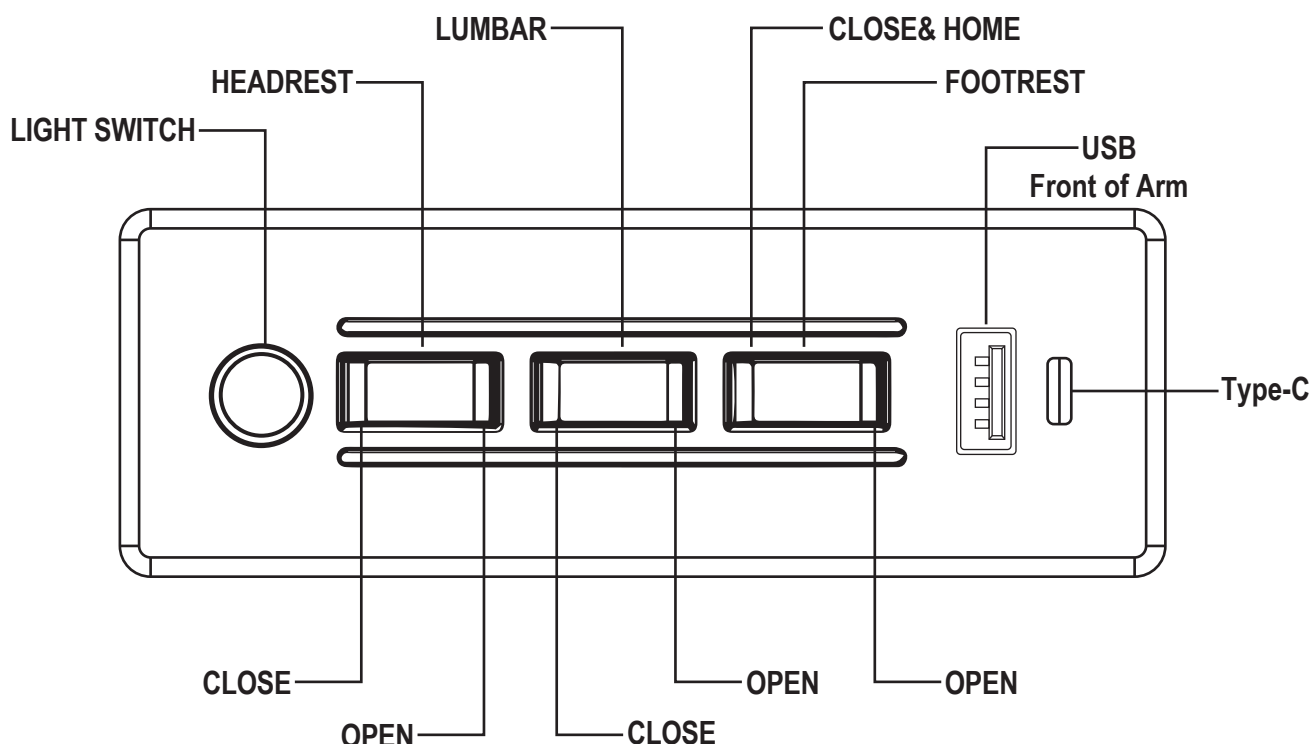

SIDE CONTROL USER'S MANUAL

Caution: Read the important instructions below before operating your power mechanized equipment
Do not allow children to play on or operate this power mechanized equipment



Care should always be taken to assure there is nothing in the path of the mechanism before and during operation.

To recline: Sit on the furniture, and press the front of the button closest to the footrest to smoothly raise the footrest and recline to any position. To lower the footrest and return to an upright position, press the back side of the button closest to the footrest.

To adjust headrest: Press the front of the button closest to the backrest to smoothly raise and adjust the headrest to any position. To lower the headrest and return it to its original position, press the back side of the button closest to the backrest.

To adjust lumbar support: Press the front of the center button to smoothly raise and adjust the lumbar support to any position. To lower the lumbar support and return it to its original position, press the back side of the center button.

To close all: To simultaneously return the headrest, footrest, and lumbar support to their original positions, press and hold the back side of the button closest to the footrest.

To turn on the led lights: Press the light switch button to turn on/off the cup holder lights and led lights under the arms.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- To avoid any risk of suffocation to children or pets, dispose of all plastic bags immediately.
- To ensure proper performance, occasionally check for loose screws and tighten as needed.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE FACTORS	SOLUTIONS
Recline doesn't recline or lift	Transformer may not connected well	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check the power supply has been correctly connected to socket• Confirm the wire from chair to transformer is firmly connected
Headrest or Lumbar doesn't work	Headrest or lumbar motor may not connected well	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check the headrest and lumbar motor has been correctly connected to socket
The side switch doesn't work	Side switch may not be connected well	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check the side switch cord has been correctly connected to plug
